Personnel Procedures

NEW COMMANDERS SCHOOL

This policy letter outlines the requirements for wing commanders, wing commander candidates, selectees, and others with respect to the attendance at the nationally-sponsored Region/Wing Commanders Orientation Course.

1. It is the policy of Pacific Region that all incoming Wing Commanders complete the Region/Wing Commanders Orientation Course offered at Headquarters CAP before they assume command. With that in mind, any member of a wing considered a likely candidate for Wing Commander or Vice Commander should attend this course. The course is normally held each winter in the month of February.
2. Any newly appointed Wing Commander who has not attended this course is required to attend the next time it is offered. Failure to attend may result in non-reappointment.
3. Members wishing to attend, other than selected or sitting Wing Commanders and Vice Wing Commanders, must hold the rank of Major or above, and be approved for attendance by the Region Commander.
